



PARTICIPANTS OF EUROPEAN PROJECT AcTive MET IN POLAND

The third meeting of the AcTive project took place in Warsaw, Poland, on September 7th and 8th 2017. The overall aim of the project is to increase the technological and digital skills of older persons focusing in particular on the use of assistive technologies.

The main aim of the third meeting was to discuss the first materials that have been developed during the first year of the project's runtime. This includes general information about technology for active and healthy ageing and different techniques to identify the needs of the (older) users. Those materials have been tested by all partners during validation workshops and the feedback will be used to improve the material.

On September 7th, a storytelling workshop was organized with a local end user organization and more than 15 participants. The aim of the workshop was to gather ideas on the development of the online platform that will be one of the main outputs of AcTive.
