

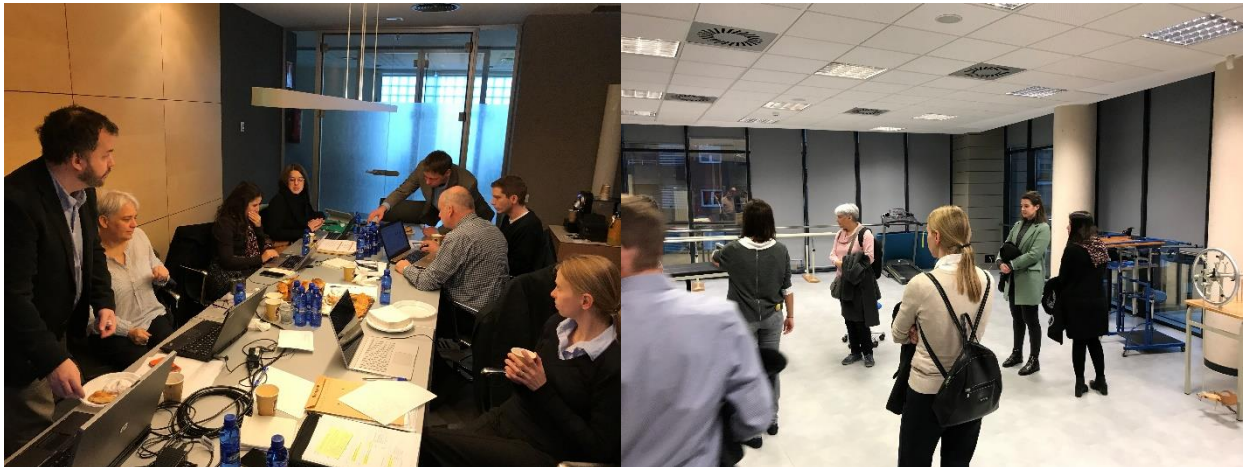


PARTICIPANTS OF EUROPEAN PROJECT AcTive MET IN VALENCIA (SPAIN)

The fourth meeting of the AcTive project took place in Valencia, Spain, on February 26th and 27th 2018. The overall aim of the project is to increase the technological and digital skills of older persons focusing in particular on the use of assistive technologies.

Hosted by GESTIO SOCIOSANITARIA AL MEDITERRANI (GESMED), the main aim of the fourth meeting was to discuss Active's learning and training materials. At first, the participants visited the public care facility "Centro de Tipologia Mixta de Quart de Poblet" operated by GESMED, where the project partner had the opportunity to experience technology supporting active and healthy ageing.

Afterwards, the partners exchange experiences on the learning and training materials. Based on the results of validation workshops carried out in each country, the project members discussed improvements of the materials.
